Talk to your pediatrician today if you or someone you know is struggling with hunger and food insecurity. REACH 4 Help by scanning the QR Code below to learn about free healthy food and nutrition programs in your area.

- Find Food Now: Food pantries are located in all 67 Florida counties (All Ages)
- SNAP: Do I qualify? (All Ages)
- WIC: Do I qualify? (Up to Age 5; pregnant, breastfeeding, non-breastfeeding postpartum moms)
- School Meals: Do my children qualify? (Ages 18 and under)

SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) offers assistance for eligible low-income individuals and families. Assistance is provided on an EBT (Electronic Benefit Transfer) card and can be used to purchase food at participating outlets.

WIC is a federally funded nutrition program for women who are pregnant or breastfeeding or who have recently been pregnant, infants & children under age 5. WIC provides the following at no cost: healthy foods, nutrition education and counseling, breastfeeding support, and referrals for health care and community services.

SCHOOL MEALS

AGES 18 AND UNDER | AVAILABLE IN ALL 67 COUNTIES

Healthy Meals are important for learning, growing, and to thrive. The National School Lunch Program (NSLP) provides nutritious, well-balanced meals including lunch and breakfast to ensure your child is focused and full during the day. School meals are provided year round for children in grades K-12. Contact your local school district to see if your child is eligible.
