ISSUES TO LEAD

- Increase the pediatric subspecialty physician workforce.
- Improve healthcare for children within publicly funded schools, including increased funding for school nurses.
- Secure continuous Medicaid coverage through age 6.

ISSUES TO SUPPORT

- Access to stock glucagon in schools with insulin-dependent diabetic students.
- Expansion of mental health services.
- Increased foster care family recruitment and retention.
- Common sense gun safety.
- Prior authorization reform.
- Copay aggregator efforts.
- Improved access to autism screening, diagnosis, and treatment.

ISSUES TO OPPOSE

- The corrosion of existing school immunization requirements.
- Expansion of scope of practice for physician assistants, nurses, pharmacists, and psychologists.
